

Applying for Trust funding? What we need to know



Recover Canterbury administers the Canterbury Business Recovery Trust Fund. To apply for funding from the Trust you will need to speak with a Recover Canterbury Business Recovery Coordinator who will help you determine exactly what level support you require.

You will need to supply some supporting information about your business in order for your Business Recovery Coordinator to assess whether your businesses is eligible to apply for funding. Your Business Recover Coordinator will then work with you to complete the Trust application.

Below is a list of the information your Business Recovery Coordinator will require. To enable your application to be progressed as quickly as possible please have this information available when your Business Recovery Coordinator meets with you.

Business History

Copies of financial reports (profit & loss and balance sheet) for the latest two years. *Internal (management) financial statements e.g. MYOB, Xero for 2010/2011 year are sought if issued financial statements are not available. They should record year-end adjustments such as inventory on hand and work in progress.*

Business Today

Statement of Current Financial Position (Assets and Liabilities)

Business Future

Profit forecast monthly for the next 12 months

Quotes

Any quotations/invoices relating to your proposed grant application.
