## RELOCATED BUSINESSES

If your business has been relocated due to the earthquake and would ordinarily require a resource consent in the new location, you may be able to bypass the usual resource management process.

The Christchurch City Council has issued public notices under the Canterbury Earthquake (Resource Management Permitted Activities) Order 2011, declaring that certain activities can be temporarily carried out in certain zones without a resource consent.

In each case, a list of criteria must be met before an activity can be carried out without a resource consent. If the criteria are met, confirmation must first be obtained from the City Council.

If the criteria are not met, a site specific approval can be sought from the City Council. A three day timeframe for decisions on these approvals is proposed.

These processes also apply to residential accommodation for persons displaced from their normal place of residence following the earthquake.
